The Foundation's fundraising centre piece each year is the long and arduous 200 mile Coast and Castles bike ride. Attended by 50 cyclists, the 2008 ride raised an amazing £25,000. Lead by Peter McKenzie, Chairman of the Foundation who himself has been diagnosed with inoperable oesophagus cancer.

The TCF decided that the 2008 Bike Ride would provide vital support for *my new hair* as the organisation's aims are an excellent fit with their own aims. It is significant that the £6,000 donation was almost 25% of the total sum raised.
